## BlackRock's Capital Appreciation Strategy Removed from the New Covenant Growth Fund

SEI has made the decision to remove the BlackRock Investment Management, LLC (BlackRock) Capital Appreciation strategy from the New Covenant Growth Fund (the Growth Fund), effective January 2, 2019.

## Rationale

The Growth Fund is being restructured in an effort to focus on managers whose strategies align with SEI's alpha-source framework. BlackRock's strategy has been removed because it did not align with an alpha source. There has been no change to the strategy's Manager Research rating.

The portion of the Growth Fund's assets managed by BlackRock will be transferred to the Fred Alger Management, Inc. (Alger) Capital Appreciation Focus strategy. We expect Alger's strategy to align with SEI's momentum alpha source.

BlackRock is a manager in other SEI Funds, and we do not expect additional changes.

## **Glossary of Financial Terms**

**Alpha:** Alpha refers to returns in excess of a Fund's benchmark.

**Momentum**: Momentum refers to stocks whose prices are expected to keep moving in the same direction (either up or down) and are not likely to change direction in the short-term.

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SEI Investments Management Corporation (SIMC) is the adviser to the New Covenant Funds, which are distributed by SEI Investments Distribution Co. (SIDCO). SIMC and SIDCO are wholly-owned subsidiaries of SEI Investments Company.

For those New Covenant Funds which employ the 'manager of managers' structure, SEI Investments
Management Corporation has ultimate responsibility for the investment performance of the Fund due to its responsibility to oversee the subadvisers and recommend their hiring, termination and replacement.
